Prerequisite Courses

Undergraduate Level

Students must have successfully completed the following courses or their equivalents at the undergraduate level earning a grade of "C" or better to qualify for admission consideration:

- Health Assessment
- · Evidence-Based Healthcare or Research Methods
- Introduction to Statistics or Biostatistics

Graduate Level

Students must have successfully completed the following courses or their equivalents at the graduate level earning a grade of "C" or better prior to entering any of the clinical courses*:

- Advanced Pharmacology
- · Advanced Pathophysiology
- · Advanced Health Assessment
- Nursing Research or Evidence-based Practice

If needed, these graduate courses may be completed at Florida Southern College as part of a student's post-master's certificate program.

Program Requirements

The final program plan and course requirements for each student admitted to a graduate certificate program will be based on a gap analysis. The gap analysis will include, at a minimum, a review of previous transcripts and course syllabi for which transfer or equivalent credits are requested. Additional documentation may be required in order to complete the gap analysis. The number of clinical hours required is dependent upon the student's earned MSN degree.

Financial Aid

Tuition deferment is available to students receiving employer reimbursement. FSC participates in all major federal aid programs including military funding.

Admission Requirements

- · Completed online application
- · Official transcripts of all academic work
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) from an accredited CNEA, ACEN or CCNE program at a regionally accredited college or university
- MSN from a regionally-accredited institution and a CCNE, CNEA, or ACEN accredited nursing program
- MSN cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Current résumé
- Required prerequisite courses
- Proof of current active licensure as a registered nurse in the state of Florida
- Record and submit three short videos (no more than 2 minutes each) answering the following prompts:
 - 1. Where do you see yourself in five years as a nurse practitioner, nurse leader, or nurse educator?
 - 2. Why is now the right time for you to begin a graduate nursing program?
 - 3. Graduate school will put significant demands on your time, energy, and financial resources. What do you see as your most significant challenges for meeting the didactic and clinical requirements for the program?
- Personal interview may be required for eligible candidates
- Completion of a criminal background check, proof of immunization, and a ten-panel drug screen prior to beginning the program (if admitted)
