

P3 APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Additional requirements may be necessary for completion, see the Pre-Professional Program Guidelines for full details.

PART 1 REQUIREMENTS

- Attend the Pre-Health 101 Workshop (*available in Fall or Spring*)
- Take PHP 1100/1997/1998 Introduction to Health Professions (*available Fall or Spring*)
- Complete the online HIPPA Training
- Complete the online Global Ambassador Training
- Participate in at least one of the following extracurricular activities: Alpha Epsilon Delta (**strongly recommended**), leadership experience, competitive internship or summer REU, intercollegiate athletics, or related employment
- Have resume reviewed by a staff member in the Science & Pre-Health Advising Center or Faculty Advisor
- Complete a *minimum* of 50 hours of professional observation and/or clinical exposure (*not including high school experience*)
- Complete a *minimum* of 20 hours of community service (*not including high school experiences; cannot "double dip" with professional observation/clinical experiences*)
- Complete a *minimum* of 3 science courses **at FSC** (*at least one course must have a BIO prefix and one course must have a CHE prefix*) from the following: BIO 1500, BIO 1600, CHE 1111, CHE 1112, CHE 2221, CHE 2222, or any 3000+ Biology or Chemistry course
- Obtain Sophomore status **and** earn a minimum of 12 credits **at FSC**
- Earn a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 and a BCPM GPA of *at least* 3.0 (3.5 and above preferred)

*By January 15th of the Second (or Third) Year:
Apply to P3 (Part 1)*

PART 2 REQUIREMENTS

- Meet with a member of the HPAC at least once each semester
- Attend the Crucial Year Workshop (*available in Fall*)
- Attend the Gap Year Workshop (*available in Fall or Spring*)
- Complete a *minimum* of 100 hrs of professional observation and/or clinical exposure (*since the start of first year*)
- Complete a *minimum* of 40 hrs of community service (*since the start of first year; cannot "double dip" with professional observation/clinical experiences*)
- Participate in a mock interview
- Write personal statement and complete a personal statement review
- Maintain or demonstrate progress towards a minimum overall and science/math GPA of at least 3.50

*By February 1st of the Third (or Fourth) Year:
Apply to Complete P3 (Part 2)*

Students who complete P3 will receive recognition of their accomplishments including a distinctive graduation honor cord, a notation on their transcript, and will be provided with a letter of evaluation (commonly referred to as the committee letter) from the Health Professions Advisory Committee.
